

### How to calculate the Grade Evaluation Coefficient

For the selection process, please calculate **Grade Evaluation Coefficient (GEC)** based on your transcript. A **GEC** is different from a GPA and can be calculated as follows. First, according to **Table 1**, please convert the **Grade Evaluations** for each of the credits on your transcript to **Evaluation Points**. Second, apply **Grade Evaluation** to **Formula 1**. If the courses you took are not based on the credit system, please replace the number of courses by the number of credits. Finally, please round the result off to two decimal places.

**(Formula 1)**

$$\frac{(\text{Number of credits of "Evaluation Point 3"}) \times 3 + (\text{Number of credits of "Evaluation Point 2"}) \times 2 + (\text{Number of credits of "Evaluation Point 1"}) \times 1 + (\text{Number of credits of "Evaluation Point 0"}) \times 0}{(\text{Numbers of all credits that you registered})}$$

Note: If the grades for the previous academic year are unavailable by the time of application, grades from the previous semester at the time of application should be used for calculation.

- 1) For applicants in the first semester of their first year of the undergraduate program, grades from the third year of high school are not acceptable.
- 2) For applicants in the first semester of the first year of a master's program, grades from the final year of their undergraduate program may be used for the calculation.

- 3) For applicants in the first semester of the first year of the doctoral program, grades from the final year of their master's program may be used for calculation.
- 4) For applicants who took a leave of absence in the previous year, please calculate from the grades of all semesters of the previous 2 years. For students who took a leave of absence in the second semester of the previous year, please calculate from the grades of the first semester of the previous year.
- 5) For courses that cannot be calculated using an Evaluation Point (course not evaluated on points but on pass/fail), please calculate GEC for the course other than those that cannot be calculated. Moreover, please report the total number of credits that can be calculated, the total number of pass/fail credits for which the applicants passed, and the number of pass/fail credits for which the applicants failed.
