

Intensive Program for International Research Output Training  
(IP-IROT)  
Application Guideline (FY2019)

**Program Outline**

In April 2013, Kyoto University launched a special project for ASAFAS students named “International On-site Education Program (IOSEP) for Global Human Resources.” The project, which is managed by the Center for On-Site Education and Research (COSER), offers several kinds of subsidy fund for ASAFAS students, one of them being “Intensive Program for International Research Output Training (IP-IROT).” IP-IROT aims to encourage students to present their research results at international stages, and for this purpose provides the following two courses:

- 1) “Prep Support Course” for IROT
- 2) “Research Collaboration and Management Support (C&M) Course” for IROT

**I. Course Details for “Prep Support Course” for IROT**

This course aims to enhance necessary skills for research output at international stages. It consists of two programs: (1) training on writing proposal in English, and (2) training on presentation skill in English (see below for details).

**(1) Training on Writing Proposal in English**

This is a training program for writing academic documents such as research proposal or grant application form, in English. In this program, your proposal will be checked by several English-speaking faculties who will make a technical advice to improve your writing. Students who take this program can get course credit named Training on Research Presentation I (Subject code: 5131).

**(2) Training on Research Presentation in English**

This is a training program for oral presentation skill in English. We welcome those who are planning to give academic presentation at international conference, meeting, workshop, etc. In this training, English-speaking faculties will give comments on the content of your presentation and will make technical advice on your presentation skill. Students who take this program can get course credit named Training on Research Presentation II (Subject code: 5132).

**(3) Eligible Applicants**

As for **(1) Training on Writing Proposal in English**, applicant must be, in principle,

graduate students of ASAFAS who have not yet submitted and passed a pre-doctoral thesis. As for **(2) Training on Research Presentation in English**, applicant must be, in principle, graduate students of ASAFAS who have already submitted and passed a pre-doctoral thesis, or graduate students who have enrolled from other graduate schools after taking master's degree.

**Please note that;**

- i . DC research fellows can also apply for this course, though they do not have priority over other ASAFAS students.
- ii . ASAFAS students who are taking a leave of absence, PD research fellows at ASAFAS, or other Research Fellows (Kenkyuin, Kenshuin) of ASAFAS cannot apply for this course.
