

# Intensive Program for International Research Output Training (IP-IROT)

## Application Guideline (AY2022)

### Program Outline

In April 2013, Kyoto University launched a project that is specifically directed for ASAFAS students titled “International On-site Education Program (IOSEP) for Global Human Resources.” The IOSEP, which is managed by the Center for On-Site Education and Research (COSER), makes available a range of funding opportunities for ASAFAS students, who can apply under the project theme of “Intensive Program for International Research Output Training (IP-IROT).” IP-IROT aims to encourage students to present their research results at international research forums such as conferences, seminars and workshops. Funding can be availed under the following two training themes:

#### **I. “Prep Support Course”**

#### **II. “Research Collaboration and Management Support (C&M) Course”**

##### **I. Details for “Prep Support Course”**

This course aims to enhance the necessary skills for research output at international forums. It comprises two programs: (1) Training for writing research proposals in English, and (2) Training for presentation skills in English (see below for details).

##### **(1) Training on Writing Research Proposal in English**

This is a training program for academic writing such as research proposals or grant applications in English. In this program, your proposal will be checked by several English-speaking faculty members who will give advice for improving your writing. Students who take this program can get course credit named Training on Research Presentation I (Subject code: 5131).

##### **(2) Training on Research Presentation in English**

This is a training program for oral presentation skill in English. We welcome those who are planning to give an academic presentation at the international conference, meeting, workshop, etc. In this training, English-speaking faculty members will give comments on the content of your presentation and will provide advice on your presentation skills. Students who take this program can get course credit named Training on Research Presentation II (Subject code: 5132).

## Eligible Applicants

As for **(1) Training on Writing Research Proposal in English**, the applicant must be, in principle, graduate students of ASAFAS who have not yet submitted a pre-doctoral thesis. As for **(2) Training on Research Presentation in English**, the applicant must be, in principle, graduate students of ASAFAS who have already submitted and passed a pre-doctoral thesis, or graduate students who have enrolled from other graduate schools after being awarded their Master's degree.

### Please note that;

- i . DC research fellows can also apply for this course, though they do not have priority over other ASAFAS students.
- ii . ASAFAS students who are taking a leave of absence, PD research fellows at ASAFAS, or other Research Fellows (Kenkyuin, Kenshuin) of ASAFAS cannot apply for this course.

## Application and Important Dates

- Approximate number of selected applicants: 10 for **(1) Training on Writing Proposal in English**, 5 for **(2) Training on Research Presentation in English**

- Result of your application: The results will be notified via e-mail by **3rd of June 2022**

### (2) Training on Research Presentation in English
